

General Information

Meter Rates / Hours

Most parking meters allow up to 3 hours and cost 25 cents per half hour (10am to 6pm). Payment accepted by coin (except Chestnut St. Lot) or by Parkmobile.

Train station meters – for Ridgewood residents only – allow up to 12 hours (6am – 6pm) and cost 25 cents per half hour. Park & Ride Lot also allows up to 12 hrs. 6am – 6pm. Costs .25/half hour.

Special 15-minute parking meters – in select street locations downtown – cost 20 cents per 15 minutes.

Daily Parking at Cottage Pl. Lot

Up to 8 hr. parking from 10:00am to 6:00pm costs .75/hour. Payment by coin or Parkmobile.

Repeat Parking Prohibited

Once the maximum time on a parking meter is reached, the vehicle must be moved from its spot to a different spot, lot or street. Parking staff will strictly enforce.

Holiday Parking

Parking is “free” at all street meters and in all lots on all of these federal holidays: New Year’s Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Lincoln’s Birthday, President’s Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Parking for People with Disabilities

There are 18 specially-designated parking spaces available for drivers with a visible valid handicap placard or plates.

If a handicapped space is not available, you may park at any parking meter. After depositing fee for the duration of the time desired, no penalty shall be imposed for parking overtime. Per NJ law, this provision shall apply only when the person to whom the placard/plates has been issued is either the driver or passenger of the vehicle.

Bicycle / Scooter / Motorcycle Parking

Complimentary bicycle racks are available for commuters at the train station (Lot # 7). There are also five spots for

Permit Parking

In addition to the coin-operated meters on street and in the parking lots, we allow extended parking by permit in parking lots.

Ridgewood Residents

Ridgewood Parking Permits (RPP) for Ridgewood Residents are available at an annual rate of \$750 to provide unlimited parking in all parking lots between 6AM to 2AM. A Ridgewood Resident Sticker is required and available for free when purchasing the RPP.

Daily Pass - Ridgewood Residents Only

Purchase a pass for single day unlimited parking using link on www.ridgewoodnj.net. Display pass on vehicle dashboard to park in any available Ridgewood Lot for \$7 and park from 6am to 2am. Free Resident sticker required.

Overnight parking is available to residents, but permits are required. Please inquire about locations, times and cost.

Visitors

Ridgewood Parking Permits (RPP) for non-residents available at an annual rate of \$1,500 to provide unlimited parking in the Cottage Pl. Lot or the Route 17 Park & Ride lot between 6AM to 2AM.

Downtown Employees

Central Business District Employee Permits are available on a monthly basis for \$80 to provide unlimited parking from 6:00am to 2:00am at the Ken Smith property or Cottage Pl. Lot.

Everyone

Coin-operated meters on the street and in parking lots are available to everyone – Ridgewood residents, visitors and downtown employees. The exception is the train station lot (#7), which is available only to Ridgewood residents. (Free resident sticker required) Payment at Chestnut St Lot (#3) is by Parkmobile or RPP. Payment in other lots by Parkmobile, coins or permits.

Ridgewood Residents

Permit parking for Ridgewood residents is available in all Ridgewood owned parking lots: Cottage Place (#1), Walnut Street (#2), Chestnut Street (#3), Prospect Street (#4), Hudson Street (#5), the Train Station (#7) and the Route 17 Park & Ride (#8).

Daily Pass available online at www.ridgewoodnj.net Display pass on vehicle dashboard for unlimited parking in any available Lot \$7/day. Free resident sticker required.

All Day Visitors

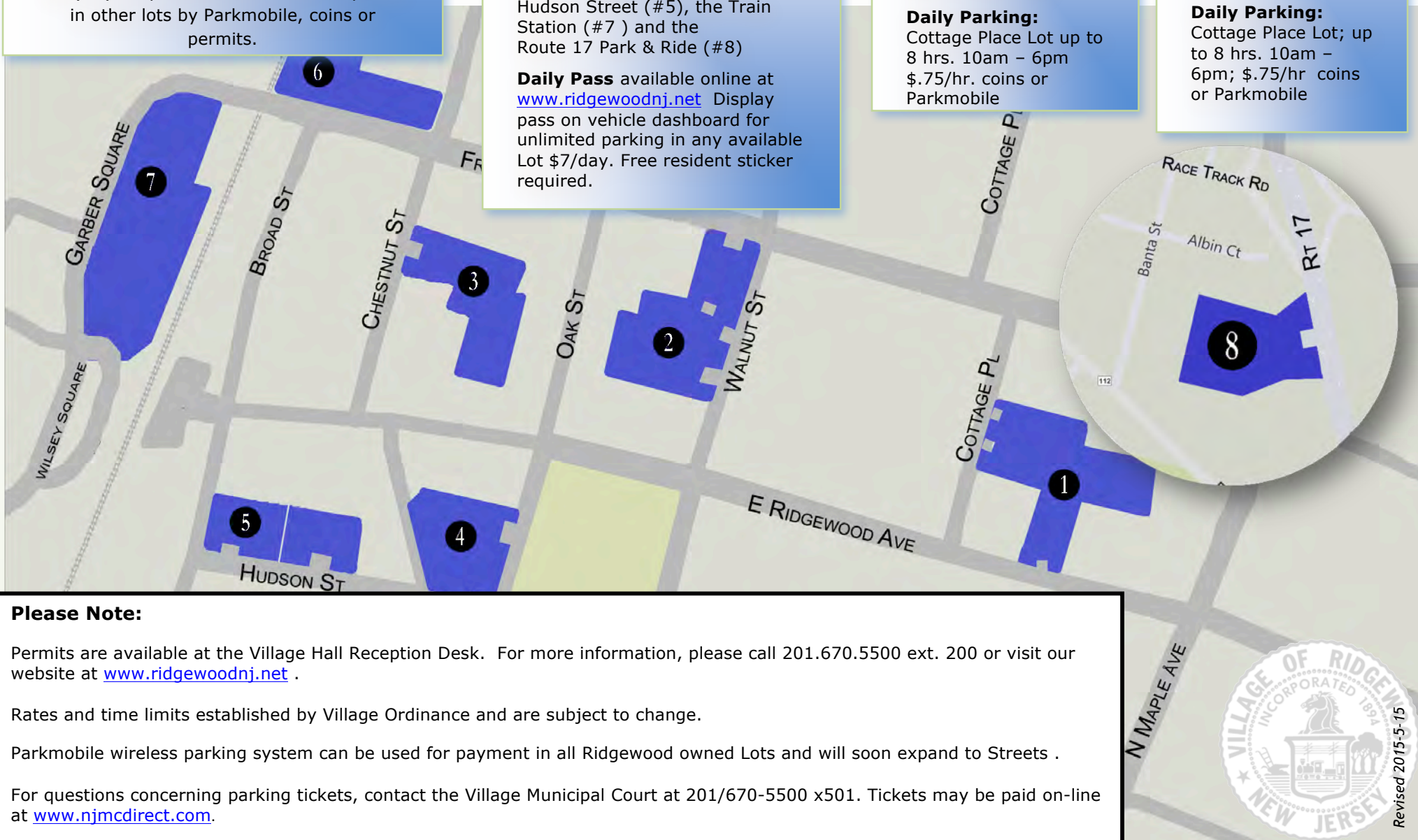
Permit parking for non-Ridgewood visitors is available only in the Cottage Place lot (#1) or the Route 17 Park & Ride (#8).

Daily Parking: Cottage Place Lot up to 8 hrs. 10am – 6pm \$.75/hr. coins or Parkmobile

Downtown Employees

Monthly Permit parking for business owners and their employees is available only in the Ken Smith lot (#6) or the Cottage Place lot (#1)

Daily Parking: Cottage Place Lot; up to 8 hrs. 10am – 6pm; \$.75/hr coins or Parkmobile
