Once again, the Ridgewood Parks and Recreation Department invites you to garden with us and join the Community Garden program located in Maple Park East and the Irene Habernickel Family Park.

The garden program is open to all residents of the Village. Returning participants may renew on a first-come, first-serve basis now through April 15, 2020. Wait list applicants will be notified of available plots afterward. The registration fee for each 10' x 12' parcel is \$ 50.00.

The original garden site is located in Maple Park, east of the HoHoKus Brook and south of Meadowbrook Avenue. Parking is available on the Public Service right-of-way, in the Stable parking area, or along Meadowbrook Avenue. The other site is located near the playground at the Irene Habernickel Family Park, with parking in the designated parking lot. Both sites offer water and a storage area for tools..

Gardeners are welcome to plant flowers, vegetables, and herbs, and may begin planting on Saturday, May 16, 2020. Each participant is responsible for the upkeep of their parcel throughout the season which attributes to the overall condition of the entire Community Garden site. While gardeners are asked to provide their own tools, plants and individual fencing; wood chips for pathways and the outside perimeter area will be made available through the Parks and Recreation Department.

A gathering with neighboring gardeners will be held on Tuesday, May 12, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. at the Stable, 259 N. Maple Avenue. At that time, a brief meeting will include an overview of the Community Garden Program, assignment of garden plots, maintenance requirements, and a garden clean-up. Horticulturalist owner and proprietor of Goffle Brook Farm and Garden Center Donna Dorsey will speak to the group on proper planting techniques.
